As the therapeutic recreation center of the Central European region we create life-changing experiences, build strength and confidence in seriously ill children and in their families in 4 countries. Our camps are entirely cost-free. We believe that the Sun always shines behind the clouds.



## THOSE CHILDREN

who fight cancer or other serious illnesses will start their journey of life with additional difficulties. Constant fear and pain leave a long-lasting scar on their soul even if they recover. They lose their self-confidence, their openness and their faith in life being a joyous journey. While they are hospitalized, they cannot attend school: therefore, encounter with peers becomes highly limited and their social skills might become impaired. We at Bátor Tábor believe that everybody has the rights to have a childhood filled with nice memories and friends and the opportunity to fulfill themselves and their potentials.

We have been helping children living with serious illnesses and their family members to regain faith in the world and in themselves for 18 years now. We participated in an international study last year that verified the positive life-long effects of our programs. Our former campers who are now grown-up adults still credit Bátor Tábor for giving them back their self-esteem, social skills and most importantly: their courage to LIVE.

# Who are we?

Bátor tábor organizes therapeutic recreation camps for **seriously ill children and their families**, as well as, for families who have lost their children due to a severe illness.



The main point of the camps is to let children **face different challenges**, and to provide them with opportunity for success and reinforcement.



Our **GO! program** reaches 2 hospitals in Warsaw and 1 in Bratislava.

In addition to Hungary, children come to us from **three countries**, Czech Republic, Poland and Slovakia. We are a regional centre.

Our Hospital Representatives recruit our campers from **47 Hungarian and 13 foreign hospitals**.

We host nearly **1000 campers** – seriously ill children and their family members – each year. So far 9500 campers enjoyed our sessions.

We **ensure overall health safety** in the camp.



All of our programs are **free**.



We independently operate our campsite in Hatvan, Hungary. The campsite can host and accommodate **246 persons** per session.

Bátor Tábor is the only member of the SeriousFun Children's Network in Central Europe. The Network includes 16 camps and 15 SeriousFun Programs worldwide. The first camp was founded by the world-famous actor, **Paul Newman** in 1988. The Network has provided help to over 864 thousand children and their relatives since its foundation.

# HEALING EXPERIENCES

The long-term effects of the sessions have been investigated by us as a member of the SeriousFun Children's Network Camp Association. Survey completed before and after the camps are conducted in cooperation with Yale University. According to the feedback of parents who took part in the surveys, it was not only their children's attitude towards their illness that had changed, but they made progress in other areas of their life, too. We are proud to say that together we really change lives!

- > 79% became more open to new things
- > 77% experienced improved self-confidence
- > 76% experienced improving independence
- > 72% developed better social skills

The long-term effects of camp were researched by the University of Utah in collaboration with the American Camp Association (ACA). According to the study former campers – even in their adulthood - credit Bátor Tábor for teaching them

- > to respect and accept diversity
- > to live in the moment
- > to face their tasks and difficulties in life with courage and persistence
- > self-knowledge which helps them see clearly what life they want to live.

The study also showed that Bátor Tábor is a special place for them where they can acquire these skills through fun challenges and experimenting in a secure and encouraging environment. The key to their success was the people surrounding them. Skilled and learnt volunteers, camp leaders, doctors and nurses created the emotionally and physically safe atmosphere that they needed to be able to evolve.

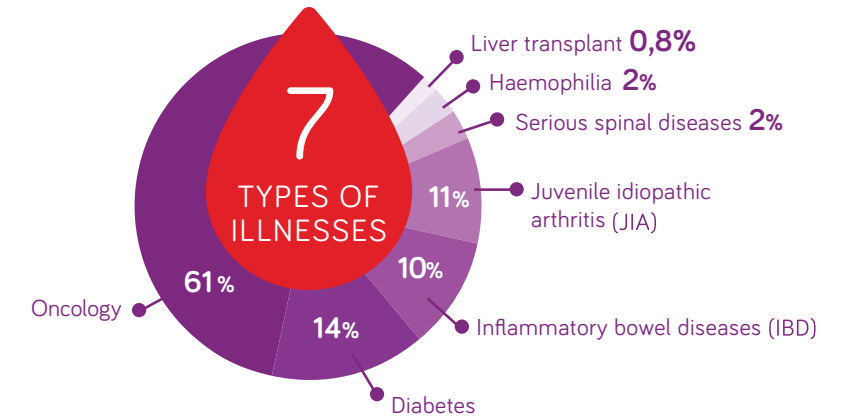
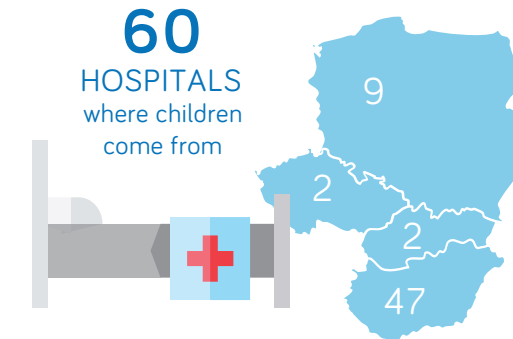

# EVENTFUL 2018

## IN CAMP

### SIBLINGS CAMP

138 children participated in our Siblings Camp that serves children with cancer or diabetes and includes their healthy brothers and sisters.

### FAMILY CAMP

75 families, 304 campers took part in our Family Camps.

### SUMMER CAMP

351 campers in 5 Summer Sessions experienced the healing of therapeutic recreation.

### SPRING FAMILY DAY

Each year, there is a day when our campers can bring their family members to visit our campsite in Hatvan and share where they had their memorable experiences. A thousand words are not enough to describe Bátor Tábor. In 2018, 731 guests participated in our Spring Family Day.



### BEREAVEMENT CAMP

The 6th Bereavement Camp was launched. Families that have lost a child due to a serious illness return to our camps three times in one calendar year. 19 families began a common journey, in which we helped with grief counseling, in addition to therapeutic recreation to aid in the process of grieving.

### WE PREPARED BRAND NEW PROGRAMS FOR OUR CAMPERS

We introduced many new programs during our summer sessions: at the Media Program the campers could get an insight to the creation of a radio show. Our oldest campers participated in the Path of the Braves activity where they acquired the skills of tying knots, building tents or giving first aid. During the evening games they gained experience about the importance of co-operation and teamwork, while they also had the chance to learn about themselves. We organized a camp leaving ceremony for those campers who were turning 18 the next year so they cannot return to camp as campers anymore.



### MEDICAL BACKGROUND

The physical safety of our campers was ensured by a group of enthusiastic and selfless medical professionals: doctors, nurses, dietitians, physiotherapists – who were actively present at camp, yet they were invisible to our campers’ eyes. Their proficiency and dedication is precious and indispensable for us.

### NEW ILLNESSES WE WORK WITH

2018 was the first year we had campers who had gone through liver transplantation or who live with serious spinal disease. Another challenge we accepted was to integrate 3 different nations in one session: Czech, Slovak and Hungarian campers spent a fun week together in our international camp for teenagers. It was exciting to see how the youth of the three countries can open up to each other, how they come over the difficulties of language barriers and how we can handle the multicultural environment.





# EVENTFUL 2018

## BEYOND THE CAMP



### FAMILY SPORTS DAY

It was the first time we organized a Family Sports Day on our campsite for our past and present Élménykülönítmény athletes and for their family members to show our gratitude to them. Approximately 250 people showed up on the event where sport challenges were in the focus designed for all age groups: from the smallest to the greatest.

### WE BECAME THE CHARITY PARTNER OF MORGAN STANLEY

Bátor Tábor was the special charity partner of Morgan Stanley Hungary in 2018. The whole company got involved in the series of charity events that we organized together with the leadership team and employees in every second month: charity dragon boat race, charity bake sale, chess competition and running is just a few of the many programs we had. The results of the one-year-long partnership were: visible CSR activities, countless community programs and 16 million HUF worth of donation to Bátor Tábor.

### ALTERNATIVE CHRISTMAS GIFTS

Some of our corporate partners decided to give the joy of charity to their partners for Christmas by supporting Bátor Tábor. They chose different ways to do so: either by buying the presents from our charity webshop, or by offering the amount that they meant to spend on Christmas gifts to Bátor Tábor. They shared the joy of philanthropy with their partners by informing them that this time instead of getting something they could have the chance to give.

### BÁTOR DESIGN PRODUCTS

In 2018 we extended the range of products in our webshop and we launched a new collection called Bátor Design. Well-known and acknowledged artists (Balázs Kismarty-Lechner, Dóra Kövesdi, Andrea Miklósvári, Dorottya Ligeti) and slam poetry writers' (Zsófi Kemény, András Kövér 'KÖVI', Péter Mészáros and Márton Simon) texts and patterns transmit the message of Bátor Tábor to the public.



### MEMORY READING

We wanted the world to know how our campers see Bátor Tábor after camp. Therefore, we organized a so-called memory reading event in April where four actors (Juli Básti, Nóra Trokán, Tibor Szervét and Zsolt Dér) presented a dramatic reading of the letters, stories, and golden sayings of our campers. Four members of Grund Improvisational Theatre (Brigi Arany, Juliska Vargyas-Tóth, Áron Biszak, Bence Csobay) were improvising on stage based on the stories that they heard.



### CHILDREN'S DAY

It was the fifth year when RTL Klub dedicated a whole episode of their well-known program Fókusz Plusz to Bátor Tábor. They did not only share the stories of our campers, volunteers and donors with the public but they also encouraged their audience to support our Foundation. More than 30 thousand people joined their efforts and decided to support our programs with not less than 16 million HUF altogether.

### ÉLMÉNYKÜLÖNÍTMÉNY – THE GROUP OF OUR CHARITY ATHLETES

Since 2010, when Élménykülönítmény, the first Hungarian Charity Running Community was founded to support Bátor Tábor, more than 200 million HUF was raised by our amazing charity sportsmen. In 2018 the legendary purple T-shirt was at the North Pole, reached Kékes - the highest peak of Hungary -, walked the full El Camino, conquered the Great Wall of China, and it appeared in Kosice, in Amsterdam, in the Mountains of Grossvenediger, and in a Sparathlon Race as well. We can proudly say that the big running races of Budapest are now hard to imagine without a bunch of Purple Runners.

**"When I registered to my first marathon a call popped up in front of my eyes: 'Run for Bátor Tábor!'. I always believed in fate, I knew this cannot be a coincidence, so I applied to Élménykülönítmény immediately. I was going through hard times back then and I am pretty sure that this mission helped me move on with my life."** - one of our runners



### CONTEMPORARY ART AUCTION

Our former camper, now a grown-up woman was performing on stage for the guests of our Contemporary Art Auction in Budapest. She was introduced by the well-known Hungarian singer Magdolna Rúza, and she sang a song that she had written for this special occasion. Our October was also very thrilling: we organized the 7th Contemporary Art Auction in Warsaw and our first Art Auction in Bratislava was a huge success. In the 3 events 186 pieces of art were under the hammer through which Bátor Tábor got 354,000 EUR worth of donation.



### CHARITY GOLF DAY

The Sun was shining bright on that day in August when we had our 16th Charity Golf Event in which 80 golfers participated. Almost 60 million HUF was raised for Bátor Tábor on that day.

### 1% CAMPAIGN

1/5 of our income is covered by the individuals who choose Bátor Tábor to receive 1% of their income tax. In 2018 our 1% campaign was focusing on the childhood values that illness takes away from seriously ill children, and we were reflecting on how Bátor Tábor can re-install those. As a result of the campaign we received 125 million HUF from 23 thousand taxpayer. There are no words to describe how grateful we are!





# VOLUNTEERING

We change lives.

Yes, the lives of volunteers, too.

## CAMP VOLUNTEERS

They are the ones who provide the physical and mental well-being of children in our camps. A volunteer in average takes part in 3 sessions, however, there are some who have been visiting our camps each year for 10 years. It often happens that their lives also change in the camp.

## GO!

With our GO! hospital outreach program we take therapeutic recreation and the healing experiences of playing to the hospital beds of children. Our well-trained volunteers frequently visit two children's hospitals in Budapest (I. Clinic of Pediatrics of Semmelweis University; and the Hematology and Blood Marrow Transplantation Ward of Szent László Children's Hospital). We organize fun and exciting programs in collaboration with other Foundations as well: for children living with scoliosis we work with Vertebra Foundation; for those who live with muscular dystrophy we work together with Gyógyító Jótétemény Alapítvány; and together with Eurakvilo Foundation we support children fighting cancer.

As the therapeutic recreation center of the Central European region it is important to us to reach more and more children every year in the surrounding countries. Therefore, we exported our GO! Program to 2 hospitals in Warsaw in 2016; and in 2017 June we launched GO! in Bratislava.

### #11 We are growing

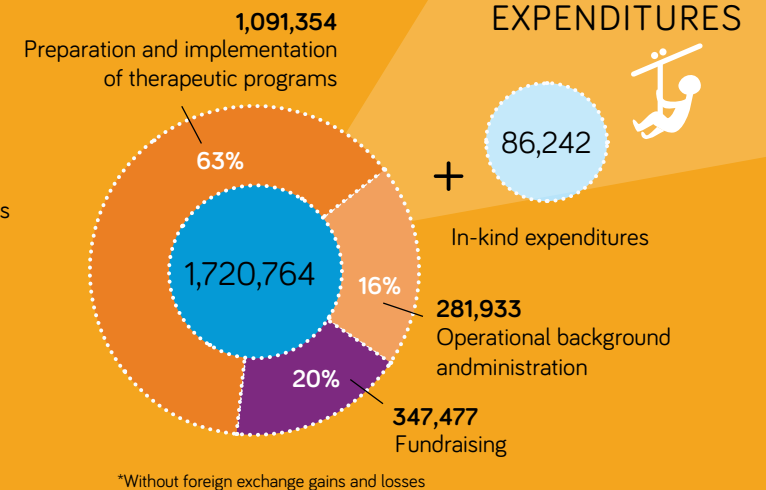
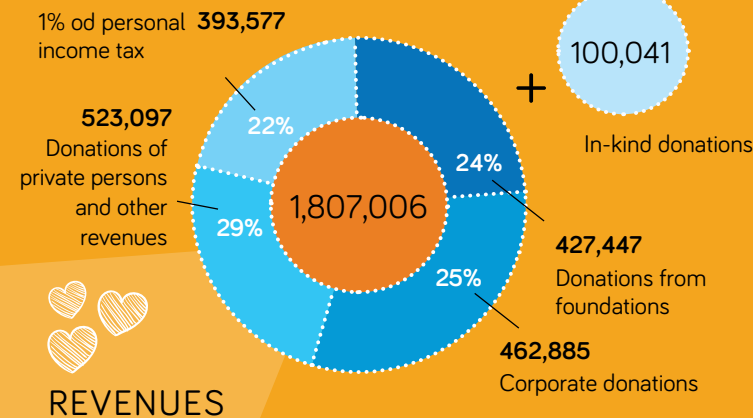
In 2001 we had 70 campers, and by now, about 9,500 campers and almost 3000 volunteers have visited us.

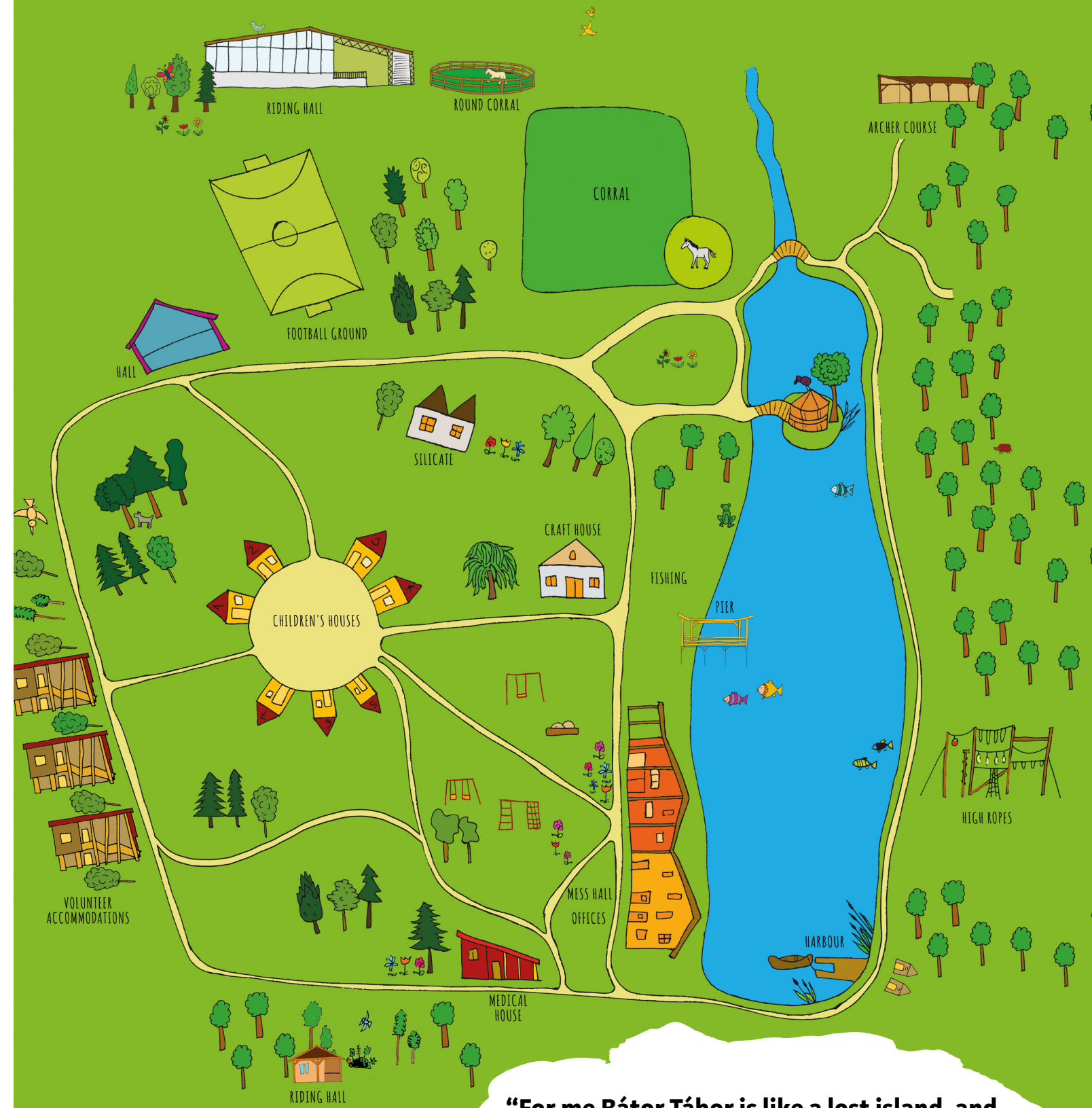
